SALVATION ARMY, NAVISTAR PARTNER TO PACKAGE ONE MILLION MEALS FOR HAITI

WHO: The Salvation Army Metropolitan Division, Navistar, Inc. and several thousand volunteers

WHAT: Packaging of one million meals that The Salvation Army in Haiti will distribute to earthquake survivors

The Salvation Army Metropolitan Division, Navistar, Inc. and several thousand volunteers are joining forces to package one million meals for survivors of the January 2010 earthquake in Haiti. Volunteers will work two-hour shifts packaging raw products -- rice, beans, soy protein, and 21 vitamins and minerals -- in plastic bags, each containing six meals. Packed meals will be shipped to Haiti, where Salvation Army officers and staff will distribute them to earthquake survivors.

Volunteers also will be helping local people in need by donating nonperishable food to The Salvation Army to distribute to people seeking assistance at its Corps community centers in Greater Chicago. For information on how to help people in need locally, visit www.salarmychicago.org.

The Salvation Army has had a presence in Haiti since 1950, with more than 700 Army officers and staff operating schools, clinics, a hospital, children's homes, and feeding programs. Since the earthquake, The Salvation Army has taken on additional responsibilities at the direction of the United Nations, which appointed the Army as a "lead agency" responsible for the care of 20,000 people living in tents near the Army's main compound in Port-au-Prince.
